#### General rules:

1. Only one exhibitor from one garden/allotment in each class (i.e. no multiple entries).
2. All vegetables and fruit to be displayed on **white paper plates, bench space 10"x10"**. **Own vases for flowers**
3. Exhibitors may remove exhibits after the trophies are presented. Any not removed will be disposed of at the discretion of the committee.
4. All flowers, fruit and vegetables to be presented so that it is clear they have been grown (not purchased) e.g. onions tops bent and tied, fruit should have eyes, stalks and bloom intact and not be polished.
